# **Board Bulletin**

Hello from the board! The biggest news from this month's meeting was the discussion and planning as current board members roll off and new board members join. We are excited to announce that we voted on adding five new board members that will begin their time next month. Additionally, we reviewed and approved changes to the COVID-19 policy addressed in this newsletter. Lastly, Marcy was given 24-hour notice to go to the capitol to testify for a committee in favor of a proposed bill that would help return rent cost for non-profit child centers. # Kid Zone Updated Covid Policy:

The CDC has recently updated their COVID exclusion recommendations and Kid Zone has updated our policy accordingly.

Effective immediately, if there is an exposure to COVID within a classroom, children who are asymptomatic at the 6 day mark, will no longer need to send in proof of a COVID test. Staff and children who have been exposed and are exhibiting symptoms will be excluded until they have a negative COVID test, alternative diagnosis and symptom improvement.

As a reminder, Kid Zone provides Banana Boat Simply Protect Mineral Sunscreen SPF 50+. Please note that Kid Zone asks that aerosol sunscreen and bug spray products not be used. Please return a signed copy of the updated form to the basket outside the office by Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup>.
